Ophthalmology Room Named For Dedicated Volunteer

Thanks to the generosity of community donors, the Ophthalmology Room at Good News Clinics has been named in honor of Dr. J.R. Wright, who faithfully volunteered at GNC for 16 years to provide eye exams to patients. More than \$27,000 was raised, with a lead gift from Walter and Winkie Bommershine made in honor of Kevin Price to recognize his dedicated and timeless work for GNC.

GNC Announces Opening of G. Warren Thomas Education Center

In August, GNC completed construction on a new building addition. The center features a patient education classroom, offices for counseling and patient intake, and administrative and Health Access offices. We have been extremely blessed by this new addition which has provided much needed space and opportunities for expanding services.

Before the addition, patient education classes were offered in the waiting room, restricting privacy and the number of students. The new education classroom seats 18-30 people, offers privacy and a quieter learning environment, and gives instructors the ability to use teaching aids such as powerpoint presentations and hands-on materials. Classes taught include diabetes, dental care, smoking cessation and nutrition education. The room also provides space for new patient orientation and in house meetings and conferences.

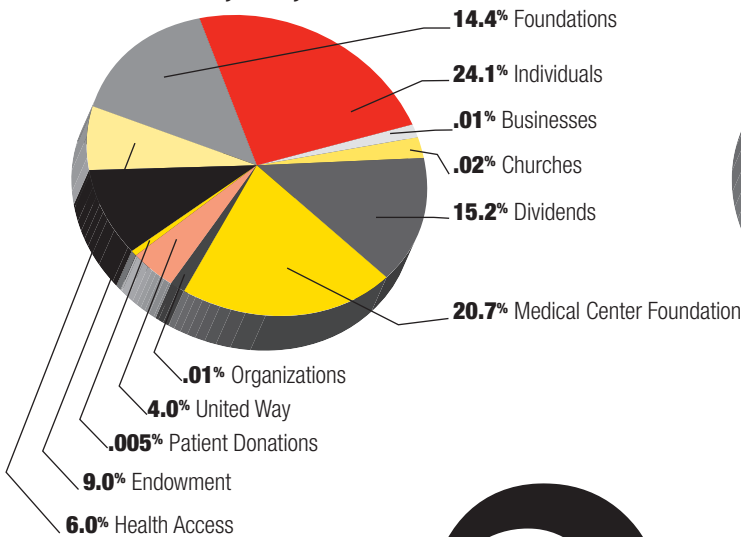

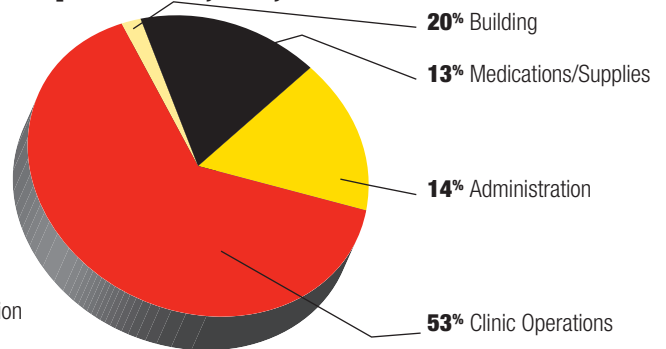
