BUILDING HOPE THROUGH HEALTHCARE

In 1992, Good News Clinics opened as a nonprofit Christian health center charged with **nurturing broken bodies and souls and providing healing for both.** With community support, the Clinics began to grow and expand, eventually becoming the largest free clinic in Georgia.

Over the past thirty years, the Clinics have grown from seeing a few patients in a local homeless shelter to being a lifeline for over 3,500 patients annually. From humble beginnings a few hours each week, our volunteer clinic has grown to include a medical, dental, and eye clinic, counseling program, specialty referrals and imaging program, and medication dispensary, all available five days per week.

ENDOWMENT

An endowment is a fund that is invested to provide on-going, predictable, long-term support for the organization. Endowments are designed to keep their initial investment amount intact and growing, using only the investment income for organizational expenses. An initial endowment campaign was launched in 2013, establishing what we now have in our endowment fund. It provides not only security for our mission now, but also ensures donors that Good News Clinics mission will endure well into the future.
